### DON'T FORGET TO USE YOUR VOTE TOMORROW - 8 JUNE 2017

Whatever your views on recent politics - local or otherwise - voting in the 08 June General Election is your chance to help choose the people who will make important decisions. Just remember that you can't give out about them afterwards if you haven't voted! Don't forget to take something with you to prove who you are - it must have a photograph of you. You can use your passport; your driving licence; a Translink Senior SmartPass; a Translink Blind Person's Smartpass; a Translink War Disabled Smartpass; OR an electoral identity card from the Electoral Office for Northern Ireland (EONI).

This is a "first past the post" election with no transfers. Vote for one candidate only by placing an 'X' on the ballot paper against the candidate you wish to vote for. Do not write anything else on the ballot paper or your vote may not count.

Environmentalist, teacher and painter Gordon D'Arcy will lead a unique celebration of The Flaggy Shore, the magical stretch of coastline in County Clare which features in Heaney's poem 'Postscript', at Seamus Heaney HomePlace on Saturday 10 June at 7.30pm.

Combining words, live artwork and traditional music, the event will see Gordon presenting a nature and live art workshop based on local flora and fauna and connecting Seamus Heaney's local inspiration at Lough Beg with Lough Muree (the setting for the poem) and the Flaggy Shore.
